


# Change in Population by Age: 2015-2035

In Viet Nam, the age 65+ population will increase 149% between 2015 and 2035 (compared to an 89% increase globally during this period). Meanwhile its total population will increase by just 13%. For comparison, Viet Nam's age 65+ growth rate ranks #27 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #4 out of 11 in South-Eastern Asia.



#### What is a dependency ratio?

An "old age" dependency ratio is the number of people age 65+ per 100 "working age" people age 20-64. It is therefore intended to measure burden on the working population to provide pensions and support for retirees.

#### How does Viet Nam compare?

The old age dependency ratio in Viet Nam is 10.7. This means there are 10.7 people age 65+ per 100 people age 20-64. Based on this ratio, Viet Nam ranks #105 ou of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #4 out of 11 in South-Eastern Asia, in terms of pressure on working populations to support retirees.



In 2015, the median age in Viet Nam was 30.4. The country ranks #86 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #4 out of 11 in South-Eastern Asia.


