

### Percent of Population Age 65+, 2017




Based on the percent of its population age 65+ in 2017, Timor-Leste ranks #115 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #7 out of 11 in South-Eastern Asia.

# Change in Population by Age: 2015-2035


In Timor-Leste, the age 65+ population will increase 24% between 2015 and 2035 (compared to an 89% increase globally during this period). Meanwhile its total population will increase by 39%. For comparison, Timor-Leste's age 65+ growth rate ranks #189 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #11 out of 11 in South-Eastern Asia.

#### "Old Age" Dependency Ratio





#### What is a dependency ratio?

An "old age" dependency ratio is the number of people age 65+ per 100 "working age" people age 20-64. It is therefore intended to measure burden on the working population to provide pensions and support for retirees.

#### low does limor-Leste compare?

The old age dependency ratio in Timor-Leste is 13.5. This means there are 13.5 people age 65+ per 100 people age 20-64. Based on this ratio, Timor-Leste ranks #79 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #3 out of 11 in South-Eastern Asia, in terms of pressure on working populations to support retirees.



Median Age: 1970-2040

In 2015, the median age in Timor-Leste was 18.5. The country ranks #179 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #11 out of 11 in South-Eastern Asia.

#### Life Expectancy (Age) At Age 65




Total life expectancy at birth among all men and women born in Timor-Leste is projected to average 69.3 from 2015-2020, ranking #141 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #8 out of 11 in South-Eastern Asia.

## Labor Force Participation Rate, 2015



The combined labor force participation rate among men and women age 65+ in Timor-Leste was 25.5% in 2015, ranking #73 out of the 180 nations and territories for which this is measured.
