


Change in Population by Age: 2015-2035

In Comoros, the age 65+ population will increase 123% between 2015 and 2035 (compared to an 895 increase globally during this period). Meanwhile its total population will increase by just 43%. For comparison, Comoros's age 65+ growth rate ranks #59 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #7 out of 20 in Eastern Africa.




